MES Kalladi College, Mannarkkad is the proud symbol of the Muslim Educational Society, Calicut to the cause of higher education in Kerala, especially to the educationally backward areas of Malabar. This is the first college started by the MES and it is also the felicitous outcome of the noble endeavor of the late Kalladi Cheriya Kunhammed Sahib and the local public. College is located in a vast area, a major part of which was donated by the late Janab Valayadi Kunhayammu Haji.

The college started functioning as a junior college in 1967 and the College was formally inaugurated on 12 November 1967 by the Minister of Education Sri.C.H Muhammed Koya. PK Abdulla IAS presided over the function. The college was upgraded in 1971 with the introduction of degree courses in History, Economics, Mathematics, Botany and Commerce. Further it was upgraded as a Post Graduate college in 1978 with the introduction of M.Com.

The departments of History and Chemistry have upgraded as Research Centres in 2016 and 2017 respectively, and are equipped with Modern Laboratories, Research Halls and Research Cubicles. At present the College is offering 20 Under Graduate Programmes (UG), 9 Post Graduate Programmes (PG) and One Integrated PG Proramme and 2 Research Centers in various Disciplines of which 11 programmes are in the Self Financing stream. This Institution has well equipped laboratory facilities in Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Physics, Mass Communication, Food Technology and Computer Science. The College Library is automated with more than 50,000 bar coded books and journals, Library has a separate digital section with broadband

internet connection and INFLIBNET facilities by which students have access to E-journals and E-books. Presently the library is in its process of modernization with RFID system. The two well equipped computer centres offer short term courses for students along with their regular programmes. College administration is facilitated with Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) software and the implementation of E-learning with ICT integrated classrooms is completed. The college is renowned for its achievements in sports and games in the national and international levels. The infrastructure includes a playground with 400 meters track, Indoor Stadium and gymnasium for physical fitness and training. The college has remarkable achievements in A-Zone and Inter-Zone arts festivals.

ADMISSION

All candidates seeking admission to the UG & PG programmes irrespective of the Quota (General merit / reservation / sports / Persons with differently abled / Mentally Retarded / Community/Management) Should compulsorily register through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) of University of Calicut.

The candidates who have not registered through CAP will not be permitted to take admission at any stage of the admission process.

Candidates seeking admission through the management Quota should submit application directly to the college office.

50% marks should be secured in the qualifying examination for admission to BBA Course.

Parent or Guardian should be present at the time of interview. Candidates eligible for fee concession should also produce income certificate, community certificate and nativity certificate and other relevant certificates for grace marks. They should also produce a true copy of the first page of SSLC/SSC showing community, attested by a gazetted officer.

All the three instalments of tuition fee can be remitted in lump at the time of admission. The parents/ guardians of all newly admitted students have to pay membership fee to the Association of Parents / Guardians and Teachers (P.T.A)

Students belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other eligible communities who are bonafide are eligible for stipend. Such students must produce nativity certificate and community certificate.

Other backward Class and forward class candidates who are bonafide subjects of Kerala State claiming fee concession must produce the Income, Community and Nativity Certificates in the prescribed forms specifying the area viz, old Travancore area or old Malabar area and sub caste, failing which they will have to pay all the fee due at the time of admission. Income Limit for fee concession for Degree is Rs. 25000/- and for PG is Rs. 42000/- per annum.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Students are bound to abide by the rules and regulations stipulated by the government, University, and the UGC from time to time. FACILITIES & INFRASTRUCTURES

LIBRARY

We have a spacious and modern library (Prof. K I Muhammed Kutty Memorial Knowledge Resource Centre) with a large collection of books belonging to diverse disciplines. General books and facilities for photocopying are provided on the ground floor, and the reference section is on the first floor. The College Library is automated with more than 50,000 books, periodicals and journals. Besides, we have a vast collection of educational CD's. The library maintains a separate Digital library section, with broadband internet and INFLIBNET facilities by which students can access e-journal and e-books.



COMPUTER LAB

The College has a well-equipped Computer lab with 100 terminals with Broadband connection, for BCA, B.Sc (Computer Science) and other courses. Besides we are also offering DCA and other certificate courses promoted by Bharath Sevak Samaj (BSS) which is approved by PSC.







AUDITORIUM

The College has a well-equipped auditorium with good audio system, Which is well illuminated and ventilated. This multipurpose auditorium is a resourceful addition to the infrastructural facilities of MES Kalladi College, especially useful for large gatherings of students at functions, cultural meets & conferences.

LADIES HOSTEL & GENTS HOSTEL

A new Ladies hostel is constructed with the financial assistance of University Grants Commission and College Management, which provides accommodation to girls. The College also has a Gents hostel, constructed by the College Management. Both the hostels have CCTV surveillance.

College has a Modern open Auditorium constructed with the financial support of Parent Teacher Association

HISTORY MUSEUM

The department of History of the college houses a Heritage Museum and replica of Megalithic Monuments. It includes a variety of pavilion of ancient Indian and Kerala living cultures. The museum provides facilities for research scholars and students.

NCC & NSS

The college has one unit in each of senior division N.C.C. Army Wing and Naval Wing and two units of National Service Scheme (NSS).

SPORTS

The college has adequate facilities for sports and games. These include a play ground with 400 meters track to promote the activities of sports, games and a gymnasium for physical fitness and training. A new Indoor Stadium is constructed in the college campus with the financial assistance of the University Grants Commission and College Management.



ARTS

MES Kalladi College, Mannarkkad participates actively in the 'A' zone and Inter zone arts festivals conducted by the Students Union of the University of Calicut in every Academic Year. The college has now reached an outstanding position in 'A' zone arts festival by bagging the offstage Championship Cup in 2017 and 2018.

WWS & SSP

Walk With a Scholar (WWS) Programme is another New Initiative Programme of Higher Education Department. It has been observed that the students of Arts, Science and Commerce in Colleges do not get necessary orientation, to prepare them for employment or guidance necessary to select areas for higher study. Walk With a Scholar (WWS) scheme proposes to arrange specialized mentoring programmes for students in the Under Graduate Programmes in Arts, Science and Commerce and to provide guidance for their future.

SSP-The Scholar Support Programme (SSP), part of the 'New Initiatives in Higher Education' initiated by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Kerala aims at imparting additional support to students in curricular areas of weakness. The programme is being conducted from 2014 onwards.





VIJAYAVEEDHI STUDY CENTER

With the support of Kerala State Rutronix Thiruvananthapuram, college started Vijayaveedhi Study Center for students and public. It is a programme under the Chief ministers 100 days point programme. It is very helpful for those who are preparing public service commission exam.

CANTEEN

The college has a spacious and clean canteen. The canteen functioning in the college campus, serves quality food items on all working days to the students and staff at moderate rate.

CO-OPERATIVE STORE

The college co- operative store opens on all working days. Essential items including books and other study materials are distributing through this store.

DAY CARE

A day care center with adequate space and all the required facilities is working in the college for the children of faculties, students and employees of the college.

INSTITUTIONAL CULTIVATION

With the support of Agriculture Department, Mannarkkad, the Department of Botany has started a vegetable garden in which organic farming is practiced. Seedlings of high yielding varieties of vegetables are also prepared. 'Karanallu' is also being cultivated.
