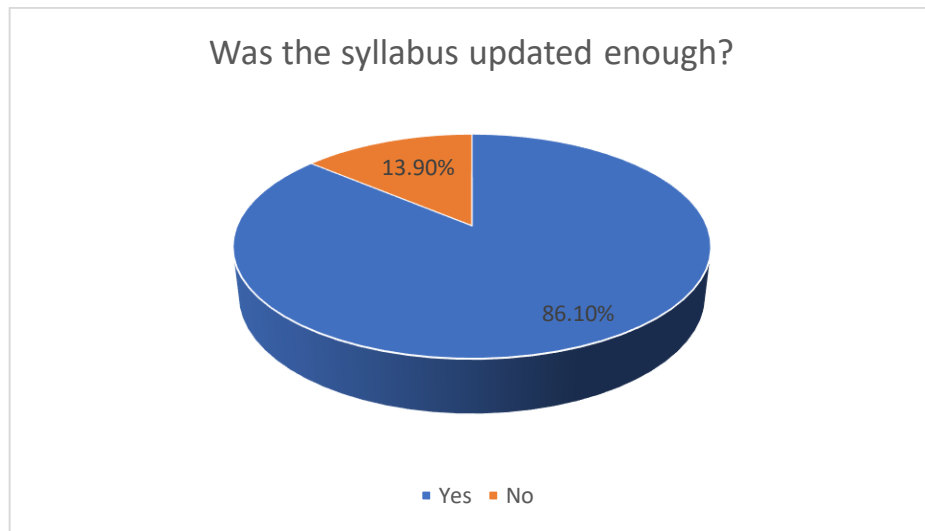

**1) Was the syllabus updated enough?**

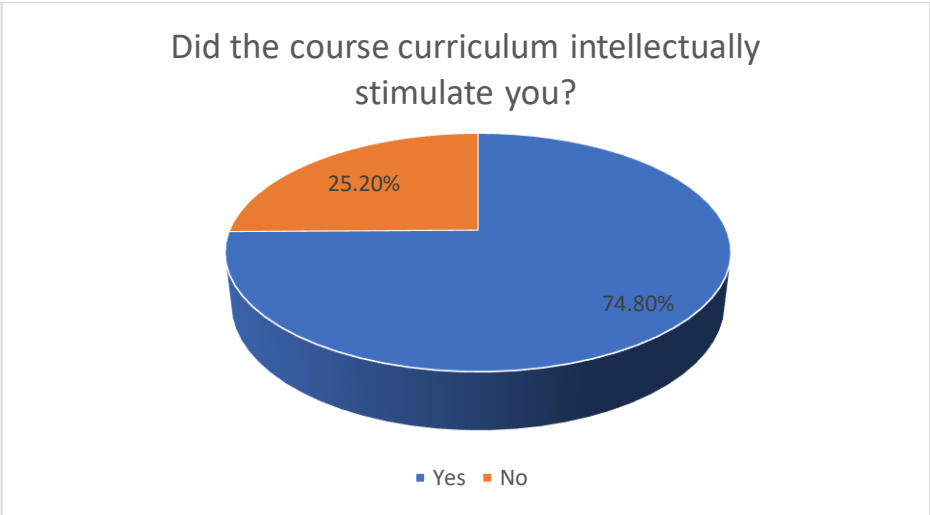

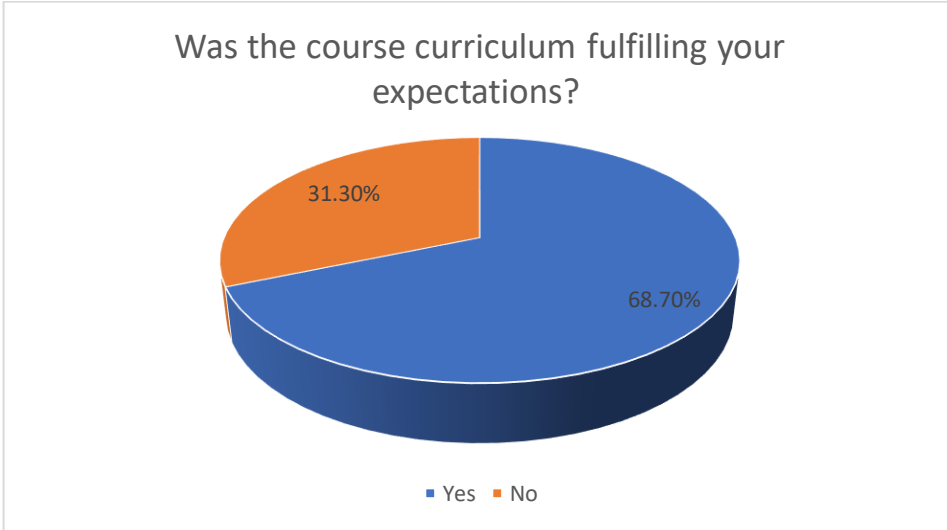
**2) Did the course curriculum intellectually stimulate you?**

**3) Was the course curriculum fulfilling your expectations?**

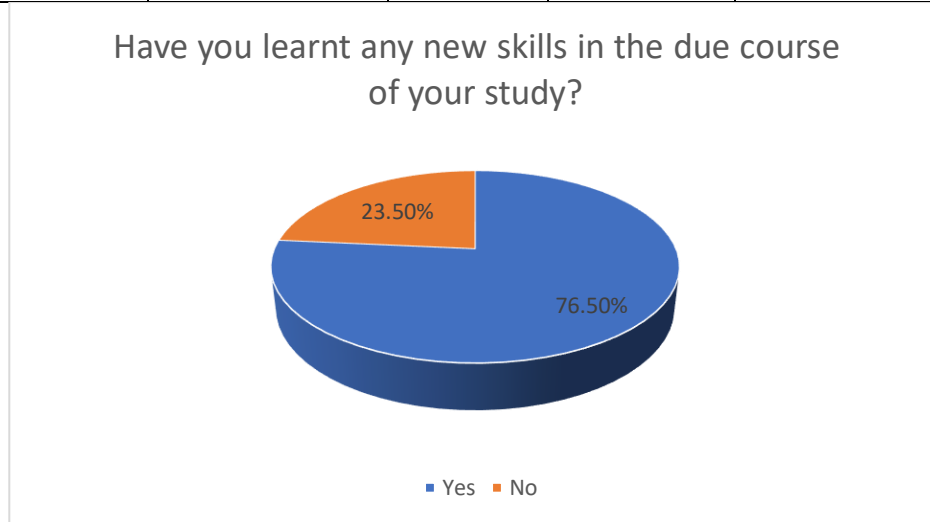

**4) Have you learnt any new skills in the due course of your study?**

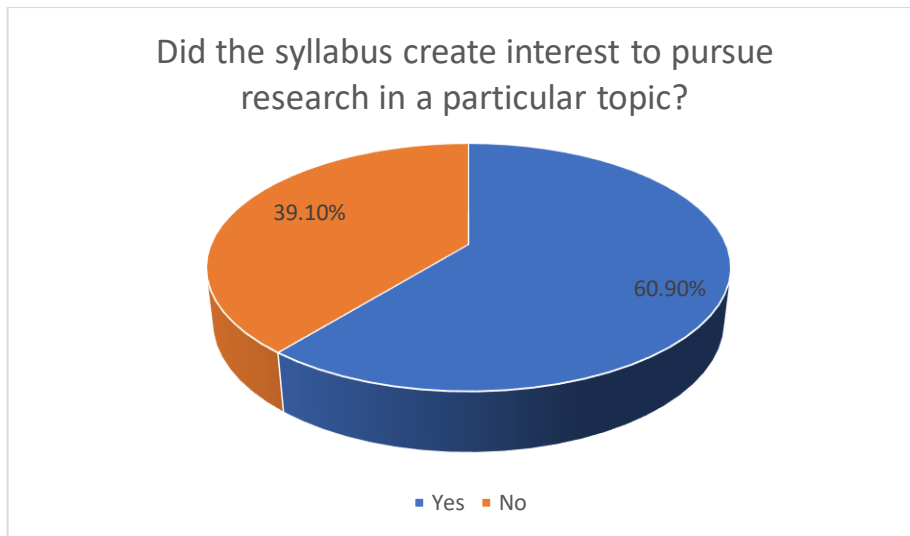

**5) Did the syllabus create interest to pursue research in a particular topic?**

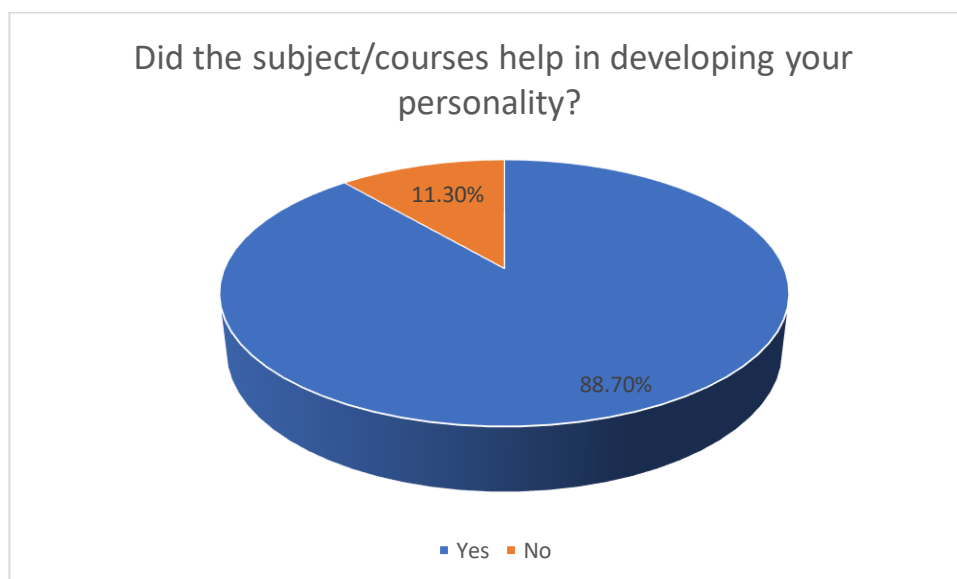

**6) Did the subject/courses help in developing your personality?**

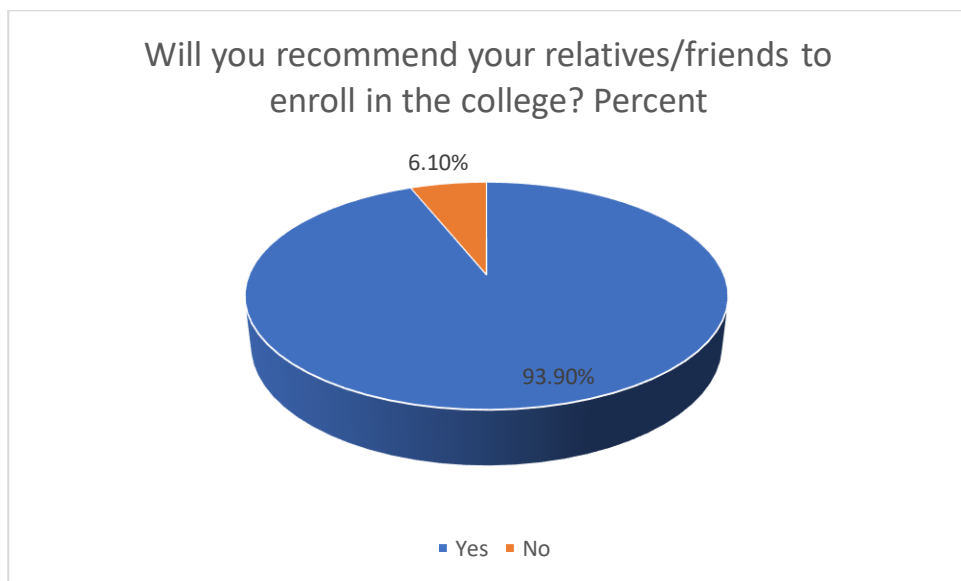

**7) Will you recommend your relatives/friends to enroll in the college?**

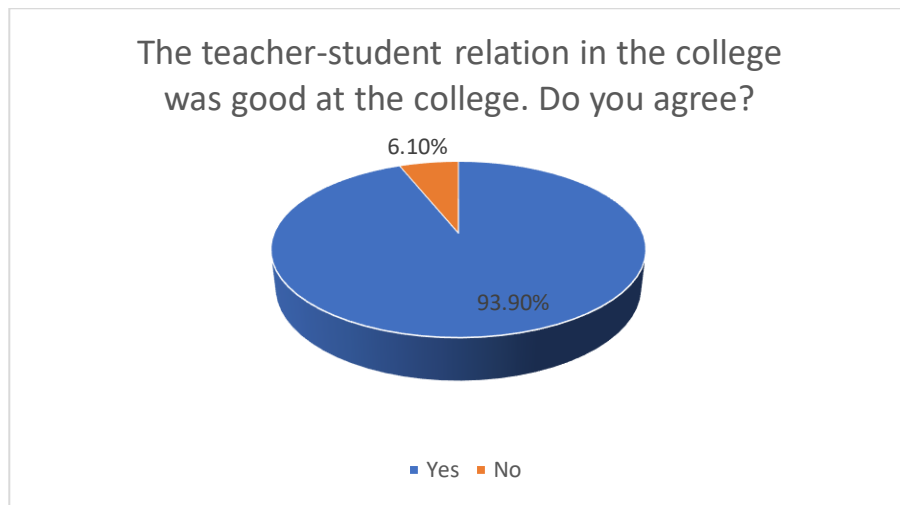

**8) The teacher-student relation in the college was good at the college. Do you agree?**

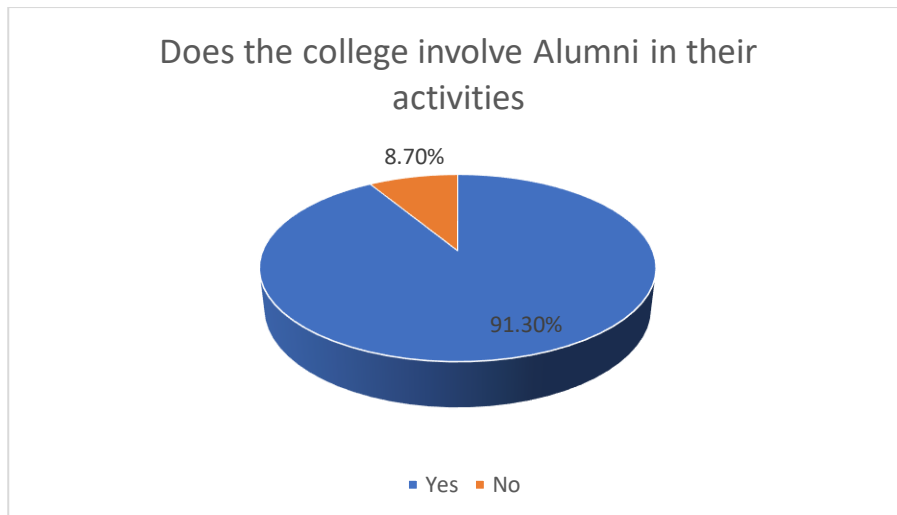

**9) Does the college involve Alumni in their activities**

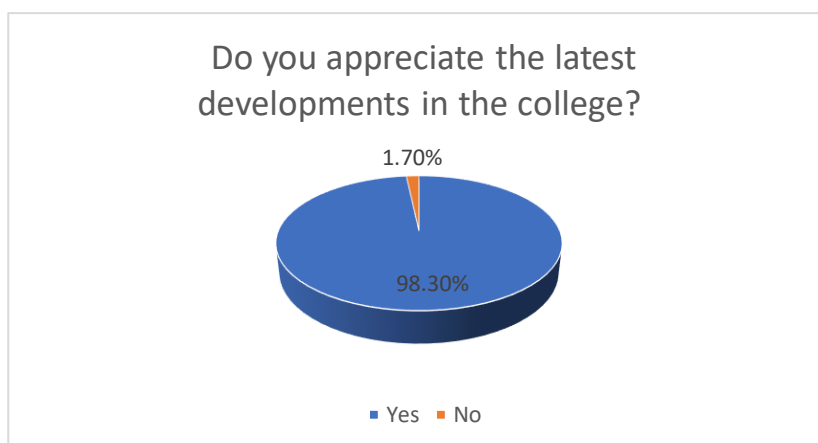
