The Minority Cell Committee shall be constituted by the principal consisting of a convener, three members from the teaching staff one of whom will be from a minority class.

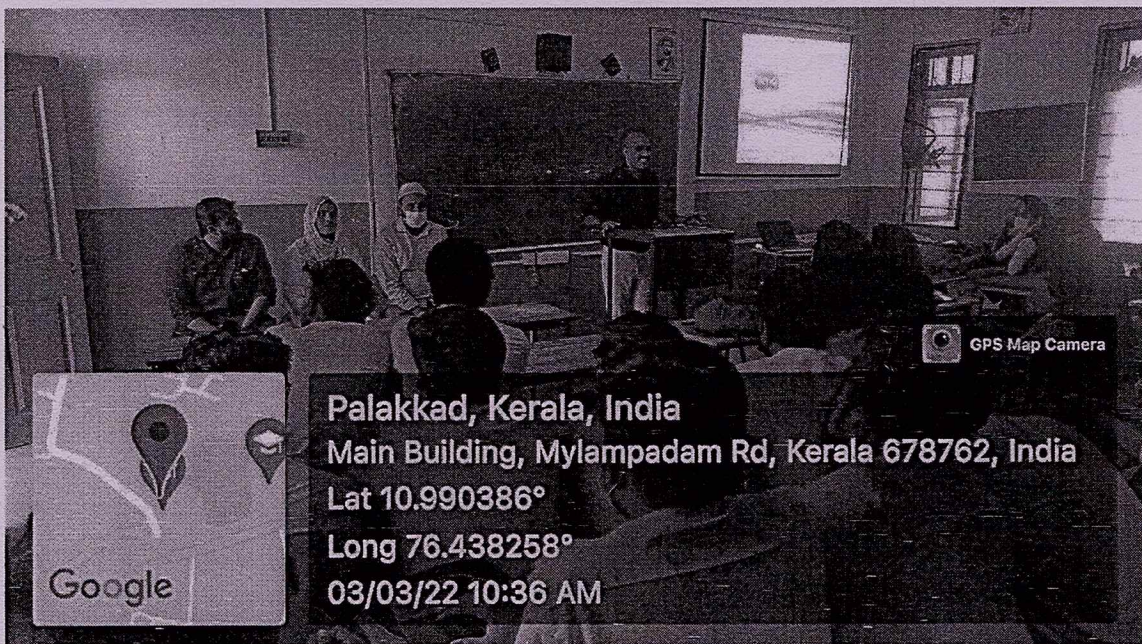

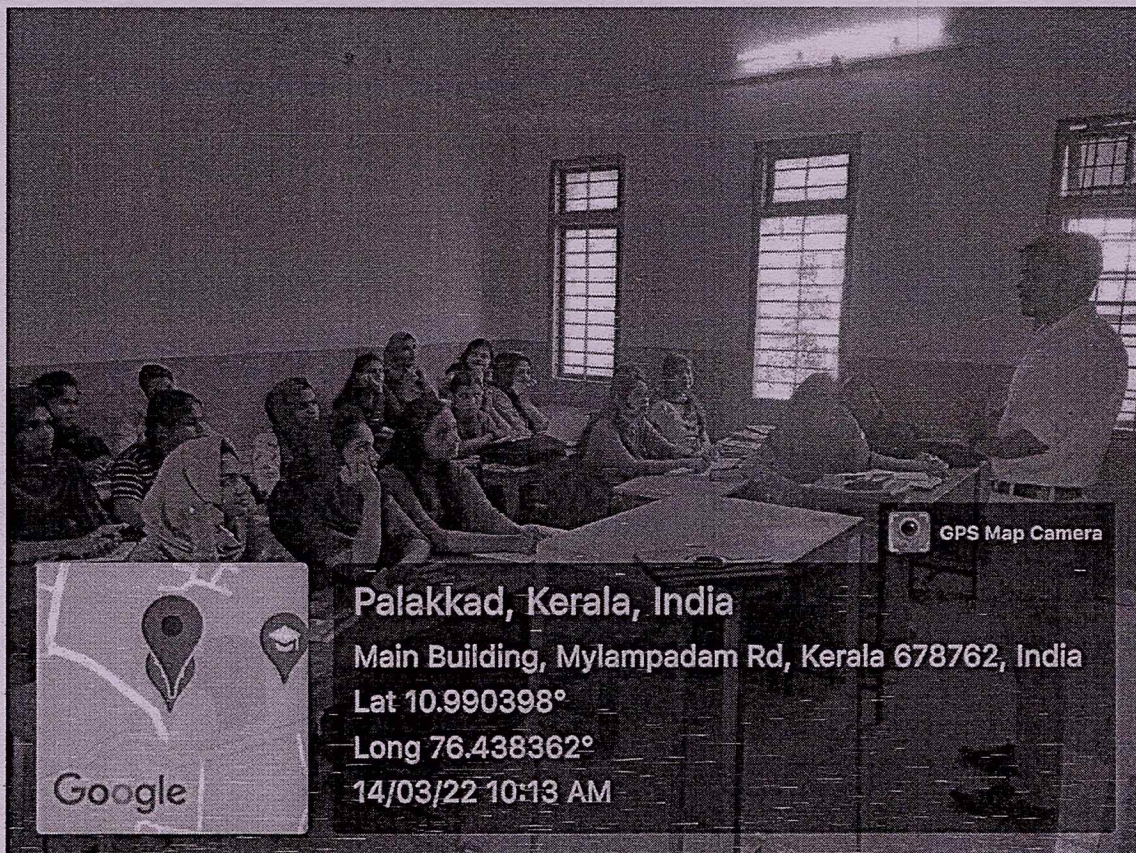
