1. Based on Meeting Action plan prepared..

- 2. Scholarship issues redressed and contacted with the SC/ST Office and authority.
- 3. The awareness classes had given to students of SC/ST community students regarding financial aids and scholarships available from both Government and Non-government sources.
- 4. Discussions were made on the socio-economic challenges, Economic inequality, Discrimination faced by SC/ST communities, and solutions to overcome those challenges.
- 5 Valuable suggestions, pre marital counselling had given to SC/ST students.
- 6. Orientation about SC/ST welfare scholarships had given on 23/10/24 by Sai Jyothi Scholarship Cordinator and Dr. Sivadasan T.P., Nodal Officer, SC/ST Cell. Information also given to apply to get the amount for study tour especially SC/ST students.
- 7 Follow up was given on the applications of students for various scholarship schemes
- 8. The Cell conducted career guidance programmes in the first week of October
- 9. Awareness classes conducted and some SC/ST students already completed PSC Registration. Facilitation centre for Tribal Students (FCTS)
