NOTIFICATION

Online Applications are invited for admission to the Under Graduate Programmes in the affiliated colleges of University of Calicut for the academic year 2020-2021.

I. Eligibility for Admission

Those candidates who are “Eligible for Higher Studies” as per the Higher Secondary Examination or a pass in the equivalent examination is the minimum criteria for admission to degree courses, unless otherwise specified.

All Candidates qualified in the annual examination held up to and including the preceding academic years are eligible for admission. However, candidates who have qualified the HSE and VHSE of the Government of Kerala under ‘SAY’ scheme and Compartmental Examination of CBSE are also eligible for admission to first year degree courses in the same academic year. **(U.O. No. GAI/A2/ 5753/2000 dated 14.05.2004).**

The candidates possessing certificate with “Eligible for Higher Studies” issued by the Kerala State Literacy Mission Authority are also eligible for Humanities and Commerce programmes. **(U.O No. 408/2019/Admn Dated: 11.01.2019)**

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of Tamil Nadu (Private study) shall not be admitted to any course under this University. (U.ONo.GAI/A1/5062/2002 dated 07.07.2005). The Physically Challenged candidates are not eligible for admissions to the Geology course. The visually challenged and deaf candidates are not eligible for reservation in Science subjects involving practical. (U.O.No.GA/G2/4053/1985 dated, 05.01.1987, letter No.GAI/A2/819/2000 Vol. II dated 14.02.2003 &U.O.No.2391/2015/Admn Dated:10.03.2015)

All candidates seeking admission to the UG programmes irrespective of the

Quota (General Merit/Reservation/Sports/Persons With Disabilities/Community/Management/Inmates of Juvenile Justice Home/Kashmir Students/Students from Andaman & Nicobar Islands) /Trans-gender quota should compulsorily register through Centralized Admission Process (CAP).

The candidates who have not registered through CAP will not be permitted to take admission to any category of seats at any stage of the admission process. The ethnic natives of Lakshadweep seeking admissions need not register through CAP. The colleges shall admit them and thereafter generate CAP ID from the college to which he/she seeks admission itself.

Candidates should go through the prospectus for Centralised Admission Process available in the website carefully before entering the registration page.

II.Mode of Registration: Online

The Online registration will commence on 03.08.2020 onwards. The Online registration through Centralised Admission Process will be conducted in Single stage.

III.Payment of online registration fee

Payment of fee for online registration can be made only through e-payment system (STATE BANK online/Nodal Centers functioning in Affiliated colleges/Friends Janasevena kendram/Akshaya kendras). Fee should be paid after the registration and final submission.

During the payment, the website will be redirected to the University of Calicut Instant Web Payment System (CUIWPS) page where the student can select the desired choice of payment. After successful payment, the applicant can log in again with the CAP ID and Password provided earlier and take final print out of the application . (In case, the payment fails, the candidate will have to re-login and do the payment procedure once again to complete the payment and obtain the print out of the application). **Print out of the application will be provided only if the payment is successful.**

Online Registration Fee

- a) For General category candidates : Rs 280/-
- b). For SC/ST : Rs 115/

IV. Last Date for Registration

1. The last date for online registration: 17.08.2020, 05.00 PM
2. The last date for fee payment: 17.08.2020, 05.00 PM

“Application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.”

The copy of the printout of the online application and chalan /payment slips need not be sent to the University, but candidates are directed to keep the same with themselves and shall submit it to the college where he/she gets admission.

The candidates should personally verify and ensure that the details entered are correct before final submission.

‘Please note that you cannot Edit/Modify your application once you click FINAL SUBMIT & PAY Button. Please ensure that all aspects of the application are correct before submitting it. Click Take Draft Printout button to view the details entered. No modification can be made thereafter.’

The candidates applying for all categories of seats including (Management and Sports quota seats) should register before the last date of registration. Application for registration after the closing date will be levied a Late Fee of Rs. 280/-

Admission to the colleges who have not cleared the dues from HWD, will be subject to the decision of the University.

Fee Structure:- The fees which students are bound to pay at the time of admission in Government, Aided and Un-Aided colleges will be published in the website www.cuonline.ac.in before commencement of the admissions.
